BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

TSG was hired to provide professional services, labor, material and equipment necessary to complete an archeological data recovery program for CA-SDI-222 and site indexing at CA-SDI-4281. The data recovery program is intended to recover sufficient information for the prehistoric deposits at the two prehistoric sites and any World War II features that fall within the Area of Potential Effect (APE) to exhaust the research potential of the cultural resources and reduce the adverse effects represented by the proposed Border Road and Fence project within Border Field State Park, San Diego County, California.

The tasks included in this project were a research design plan, an exploration of subsurface areas or the site to determine if any intact deposits were present, a site indexing program to document cultural resources, archeological monitoring to ensure that no unanticipated cultural resources were affected, laboratory analysis of any artifacts or cultural resources discovered including shell species identification, faunal analysis, otolith analysis, oxygen isotopic analysis, radiocarbon dating, obsidian sourcing and hydration, and blood residue and phytolith studies. Task to be performed include preparation of a field summary report, technical synthesis report, and a curation plan.
