BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

TSG was contracted to update the Fort Hunter Liggett and Camp Parks Integrated Cultural Resource Management Plans (ICRMP), and prepare an initial ICRMP for Moffett (Field) Housing. Primary ICRMP tasks to be included in the documentation consist of preparing NHPA Section 106 documentation, conducting cultural resource inventories, site testing and evaluation, implementing protection measures, monitoring ground disturbing projects, architectural history assessments, and other similar actions. The updates include changes since initial federal legislation, in Army policy, and in cultural information. Three project sites that encompass approximately of 195,000 acres (facilities vary between 100 acres and 164,000 acres) of land located in Monterey, Alameda, Contra Costa, Santa Clara counties, California. The work is of a complexity and diversity of type associated with NEPA, ARPA, NAGPRA and NHPA Section 106.
