La Cueva Pintada Rock Art Inventory Update, Fort Hunter Liggett, Monterey County, California

### BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

TSG was retained to conduct a complete and thorough inventory of the rock art (National Register Site CA-MNT-256) using previous panel designations in the 1980 La Cueva Pintada Technical Report by Breschini and Haversat, and to evaluate current conditions. The project also included the analysis of the data from the previous Section 110 Project. A photographic inventory of rock art panels utilizing digital color format for a visual record was used for analysis and for resource management/protection evaluation. Supplemental drawings and measurements were performed as needed and



scaled drawings of any new panels were completed where necessary. For each loci at CA-MNT-256, all site information was updated using the appropriate DPR forms. Data analysis of the digital images included the use of the D-Stretch program method to determine if other images are present and establishes a baseline of that data including recording forms and scaled drawings as appropriate. Comparison of digital photos taken as part of this study was used to evaluate natural deterioration and any occurrences of vandalism. All work was performed and evaluated by highly qualified and experienced archaeological professionals with expertise in this area of study.
