### BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

TSG is under contract to provide environmental support in accordance with performance work statement - Cultural Resource Management Technical Support, U.S. Army Combat Support Training Center, Fort Hunter Liggett (FHL) California. The support includes assisting in implementation of the installation Integrated Cultural Resource Management Plan (ICRMP) as prioritized by the Combat Support Training Center (CSTC) and Cultural Resources Manager (CRM). Work is being performed in compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA), the Archeological Resource Protection Act (ARPA) and the Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act (NAGPRA). Primary ICRMP tasks include preparing NHPA



Section 106 documentation, conducting cultural resource inventories, site testing and evaluation, implementing protection measures, monitoring ground disturbing projects, architectural history assessments, and other similar actions. The primary tasks require skill sets related to archaeology,

historical research, architectural history, database management, records management, archiving and curation. Additional studies have included preparation of a geologic map and report for the FHL military installation, incorporating existing data from published United States Geological Survey and other geologic maps, and summarizing the data into a usable installation-specific document for future planning purposes. In addition, a report addressing the significance of geological affects acting upon the preservation of pre-historic archaeological sites within FHL was prepared.
