

## *Related Project Experience - The Sanberg Group, Inc.*

**PROJECT TITLE AND LOCATION:**

Fire Stie Recordation, Kelly and Martin Creek Fireline Class III Inventory, Humboldt County and Lander County, Nevada

**YEAR(s) PROFESSIONAL SERVICES PROVIDED:**

September 2008 through December 2008

**BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:**

The Kelly and Martin Creek Fireline Site Recording and Evaluation project consisted of the relocation of several sites, evaluation/re-evaluation of some sites, mapping of disturbance, and evaluation of damage to the National Register eligibility values of several archaeological sites. The Kelly Creek Spring Site was found to be approximately 52 acres, containing both prehistoric and historic components. The site was affected by fire suppression activities relating to the Kelly Creek Fire in July 2007. The Martin Creek Fire project area included recording, evaluating National Register eligibility, and mapping and evaluating damage to the previously unrecorded historic China Road. Before commencement of fieldwork, a literature and records search was conducted to identify known resources and areas with a high probability of containing resources in primary context. Other tasks included mapping on IMACS long forms including mapping and evaluation of damage to the National Register values of both sites. A final report was compiled and submitted.
