

**PROJECT TITLE AND LOCATION:**

Litigation Support and Expert Testimony – former Weber Aircraft Facility, Burbank, CA

**YEAR(s) PROFESSIONAL SERVICES PROVIDED:**

**BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:**

***A) Cost Allocation Testimony –former Weber Aircraft facility, Burbank, CA***

Services pertained to allocation (allocation of responsibility) of the former Weber Aircraft facility costs internal to a PRP group allocation, a subset of the allocation between Lockheed and the PRP group, this total allocation being \$172 million. Allocation was specific to the long-term operation and maintenance of the San Fernando Superfund Site – Burbank Operable Unit treatment, blending and related facilities, (including extraction, treatment, blending, and reinjection of groundwater), dismantling and decommissioning of facilities upon completion of remedy, and reimbursement of EPA and DOJ costs. Actions reportedly resulted in the shutdown of 27 of 35 supply wells due to the presence of TCE/PCE in groundwater, with concentrations up to 32,000 ppb of TCE. Allocation was based on historical site practices (storage [UST tank farm and ASTs, clarifiers, etc.], process and disposal), soil contamination (including number of boreholes, type of soil, and depth to groundwater), and distance to groundwater receptor for contaminants including TCE and PCE.

***B) Litigation Support – former Weber Aircraft facility, Burbank, CA***

Mr. Traylor provided expert witness testimony pertaining to projected costs, including status of remediation, projected activities and future costs at the Weber sites in support of mediation. The testimony was exclusive of past matters including operating and disposal practices, past investigation results and remediation or previously incurred costs. Anticipated remedial activities included excavation of soils impacted with chromium; VES operation and maintenance; VES system review and enhancement, groundwater monitoring; and regulatory interaction and reporting.
